Benefits Investigation

AVEO ACE will to determine your patient's eligibility and coverage for FOTIVDA

Prior Authorization and Appeals Support

AVEO ACE provides guidance through the PA and appeals process and will notify you of status updates

Pharmacy Coordination

AVEO ACE will triage prescription to preferred network pharmacy or in-office dispensing location

Nurse Support Program

The AVEO ACE Program offers a personalized Nurse Support Program that provides:

- General education on FOTIVDA treatment and what to expect while on treatment

Co-Pay Support

Patients who have commercial or private insurance may be eligible to enroll in the AVEO ACE Co-pay Assistance Program. If approved, your patient could pay as little as \$0 for their FOTIVDA. Annual limits of up to \$25,000 apply

Patient Assistance Program

Patients who are uninsured or underinsured may access FOTIVDA free of charge through the AVEO ACE Patient Assistance Program

Quick Start Program

Provides free FOTIVDA to eligible patients who experience a payer decision delay of 5 business days or more

Bridge Program

Provides free FOTIVDA to eligible patients who experience coverage interruptions while already on treatment

AVEO ACE Quick Start Program Overview

AVEO Oncology's Quick Start Program provides newly prescribed, eligible patients a 7-day supply of FOTIVDA® at no cost in the event of a coverage-related delay. If coverage delays persist, patients may receive up to 30 days of medication at no additional cost



How Does The Quick Start Program Work?

1 Submit AVEO ACE Patient Enrollment Form

AVEO ACE provides support during the coverage review and claims process and provides eligible patients access to the **Quick Start** and **Bridge Programs**

2 Patient Verification and Dispensing

- The AVEO ACE Program will verify a patient's eligibility for Quick Start or the Bridge Program in the event of coverage delays or disruptions
- Eligible Quick Start Patients will receive a 7-day supply of FOTIVDA
 - -Based on the nature of the delay, the AVEO ACE Program may determine if additional supply is appropriate*

Select Quick Start Program Eligibility Criteria:

- ✓ The patient must be a resident of the U.S. or a U.S. territory
- The patient must have a valid, on-label FOTIVDA prescription from their healthcare professional (HCP)
- The patient must have commercial or government prescription drug insurance coverage
- Coverage determination has not been received within 5 business days of required prior authorization submission; OR:
- HCP determines there is a medical necessity that the patient start therapy immediately

*The default Quick Start supply is seven (7) days. Based on the nature of the delay, the AVEO ACE Program may dispense up to a 21-day supply (total). In the event that an insurance delay exceeds thirty (30) days, an additional Quick Start prescription can be submitted by the HCP for patients actively pursuing coverage
